History of the Chevening scholarship

- Established in 1983 by the Foreign & Commonwealth Office
- 'Chevening House' is the name of the official country residence of the British Foreign Secretary.
- In 1994 Douglas Hurd, then Foreign Secretary, renamed the Foreign & Commonwealth Office's Scholarships and Awards Scheme - 'The British Chevening Scholarships Programme'
- Chevening Programme is funded by the FCO and is administered by the Association of Commonwealth Universities

Priority areas

- Legal system reform and the rule of law
- Economic, energy and competition reform
- Human and minority rights
- Public administration reform
- Conflict prevention and post-conflict reconciliation

Chevening candidates

- Postgraduate students and young professionals
- Chevening is for MA only (not PhD or undergraduate)
- Academic excellence and leadership potential
- A proven track record of success in their chosen field (at least two years of relevant work experience in Serbia)
- English language test (Academic IELTS, Pearson PTE Academic, TOEFL iBT, Cambridge English: Advanced (CEA), Trinity ISE II (B2))

Which costs are covered by Chevening?

- university tuition fees (for MBA £18,000 cap)
- a monthly stipend
- travel costs to and from the UK
- an arrival allowance
- a homeward departure allowance
- the cost of one visa application
- a travel grant to attend Chevening events in the UK

Essential for application:

- Two references to be provided in a letter format and written in English
- Valid passport/national ID card
- University transcripts (undergraduate, postgraduate)
- Three different UK Master's course choices

** Please note that only documents in PDF format can be uploaded and documents cannot be over 5MB in size.*

Optional:

- English language (if already met the requirements)
- UK Master's university offer (if already met the requirements)

- Don't submit your application unless you are completely satisfied with it
